OPERATIONS REPORT: Maintenance

Lift Station 11 both pumps were replaced by Quality Flow on a near emergency basis. One pump was barely working and the other was inoperable. Jacobson motioned to authorize expenses retroactively, Badman seconded. Motion passed.

HARVEST REPORT:

Equipment has been delivered to storage. Fee will be \$1200 for all three pieces (Truck, Harvester and Elevator).

NEW BUSINESS:
